

The Court doth certify that John Taylor is a free person of mixed blood upon the testimony of James W. Parker a white person of the County of South-
#ampton.

The Court doth assign Richard Barrett guardian of Erastus Barrett his infant son. Whereupon he gave bond and security according to Law.

Ordered that Nancy Brown a free negro and her son George Brown be summoned here to the September Term of this Court to show cause if any they can why the said George Brown should not be bound out by this Court.

Juba a slave belonging to the estate of Jeph. Gardner dec'd who stands charged with a felony by him committed in this County and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this that he did on the fourth day of July in the year 1855, maliciously cut and wound, and by other means cause bodily injury to Richmond Edwards (a white person) with intent to kill the said Richmond Edwards was this day again set to the bar in custody of the Sheriff of this County and being arraigned pleaded not guilty; And the Court having heard the evidence are unanimously of opinion that the said slave Juba is guilty of the offence whereof he stands charged. And it being demanded of the said slave Juba if any thing he had or knew to say why the Court should not now proceed to pronounce judgment on him and nothing being offered or alleged in arrest or delay of judgment. It is considered by the Court that the said slave Juba be sold and transported beyond the limits of the United States. And the Court proceeding to value the said slave Juba doth fix the same with a knowledge of his condemnation at eight hundred Dollars,

Samuel Williams who stands bound in a recognizance to appear here on this day to answer the Commonwealth for and concerning a certain affray by him committed by unlawfully and maliciously shooting Thomas B. Smith sometime in the month of January last. This day appeared in Court in discharge of his said recognizance.

The Court doth certify that Levi Sandley is the legally qualified guardian of Benjamin S. Sandley minor child of Thomas Sandley dec'd. It appearing to the Court to be for the interest of the said minor child it is ordered that the said guardian sell for the highest price he can obtain for the said abutment land warrant No 10,403 issued under the act of Congress of March 3rd 1855, for his father's services in the war of 1812.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning ten o'clock
