This day came the defendant Mumfords by his attorney and pleaded not guilty to which the attorney for the Commonwealth replied generally and thereupon came a jury, Emory Littleton Jory Lawrence Luter, Orman Bryant, Jeremiah Kifflet, Edmund Kitchin, Calvin Barberough, John Ruttle, John Gardner, Nathan S. Thomas, John C. Croft, Emory Whithead, and Lawrence Gardner, who being selected by lot, tried and sworn the truth to speak upon the issue joined upon their oath returned a verdict in the following words: "We the jury find the defendant Mumfords guilty and assess his fine the fifteen Dollars." And on the motion the defendant Mumfords and for reasons appearing to the Court the said verdict is set aside and a new trial is granted him to be had at the next quarterly term of this Court designated for the trial of civil causes upon condition that the said defendant Mumfords ^{pay the costs} of this trial. And the defendant Manning being solemnly called but came not, whereupon on the motion of the attorney prosecuting for the Commonwealth, a writ of capias is awarded against the said defendant Manning returnable him in the first day of the next quarterly term of this Court designated for the trial of civil cases.

On the motion of Wm. Mumfords who made oath and gave bond & security according to law, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of
