Croft, Lawrence Luter, and Orman Bryant one Dollar each for their services on this day as Jurors in the trial of misdemeanors and prosecutions on behalf of the Commonwealth to be paid out of the Public Treasury of this State.

The Court doth allow William Beale, Edwin N. Williams, James Crook, and John Lowe fifty cents each for their services on this day as Jurors in the trial of civil cases to be paid out of the County Levy of this County.
