to Mrs. Mary Stuy. and that she pay annually for the services of the apprentices five dollars each after they arrive to the age of 25 years respectively, which amounts are to remain in her hands and to every interest respectively from the end of each year as they become due and to be paid to the apprentices respectively as they arrive of age. And the overseer of the Poor by whom this order shall be executed shall take of the misdeeds bonds in satisfaction of double the amount for the whole period.

Ordered that the black register from a Crocker and Blamson Crocker, free negroes who were born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Thomas Riddle, and Robert Diggs free negro who was born free in this County as appears from his former register.

On the motion of Diggs, Sumner & Diggs merchants in this County. It is ordered that the sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next term of this Court for the purpose of enjoining into the propriety of authorizing them to sell by retail, and not by spirits or a mixture thereof, at their store.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term
