

Secund^o Current and Commissioners reported James St. Monroes guardianship of Benjamin & Wm. of Edward W. Wm. of Andrew J. Wm. and of Martha J. Elijah Jones, Osman Bryant and Benjamin J. Bryant are appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs of the Bridge across Jenkins Mill pond and to receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

On the motion of Miles Story to change the road near his house it is ordered that Seth St. Bishop, Parker D. Story and W^m E. Reale be appointed viewers to view the ground and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as the public if such road shall be changed as proposed, and especially whether any yard, garden, orchard or any part thereof, will in such case have to be taken.

On the motion of Saml. Hill, Sheriff of this County, Shugars Linn, Mills D. Sumner & George Vick are permitted to qualify as his Deputies. It being the opinion of the Court that they are persons of honesty, probity and good demeanors, and thereupon they took the several oaths prescribed by law.
