On the motion of Ruggs, Sumner & Ruggs merchants in this County who wish their License to include permission to sell by retail Ardent Spirits or a miscellan thereof, at their store in this County, and who produced the sheriff's receipt for the Tax imposed by law, the Court doth certify that they are persons of good character and see no objection to granting such permission.

On the motion of James M. Mangum guardian of Martha A. Andrews and Edward M. Wrenn he is allowed to expend the sum of fifty dollars of the principal of each of his said wards estates for their support &c.

On the motion of James M. Mangum guardian of Benj. S. Wrenn he is allowed to expend the sum of one hundred dollars of the principal of his said wards estate for his support &c.

On the motion of Jonathan Darden he is exempted from the payment of all Taxes & levies on his negro woman Selva. she being old & infirm.

Ordered that Wm^o D. Moore, Willis M. Lawrance & N. B. Council be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the Bridge near old South Quay and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

And on the motion of Benjamin Buffum who made oath and together with James G. Ordered that Miles McNeill, Jonathan S. Buffum & Orville S. Hill being sworn for the purpose do a separate all the goods in chattels of Susanna Barnes dec^d, that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.
