It is adjudged, ordered and decreed that the said Commissioner appertain the amount due from the said administration amongst the several creditors who have proved their debts as aforesaid, that he ascertain the amount due each and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required so to do by either of the parties.
