 costs. And that the plaintiff recover of the defendant the costs of
 the proceedings herein.

Upon satisfactory evidence presented to the Court, it doth certify that Elizabeth Thomas of this State and County to whom bounty land warrant Number 38,940 for one hundred and twenty acres was issued on the 24th day of December A.D. 1853, under the act of Congress of March 3rd A.D. 1855, died in the said State and County on the 27th day of January A.D. 1856, intestate, leaving as her only heirs at law her children, to wit; John W. Thomas, Judith C. Thomas, Benjamin R. Thomas, George W. Thomas, Ann Thomas, and Fanny L. Thomas all of whom are above the age of twenty one year (and are now living).
