

Take the building of an embankment at the Flat Swamp bridge.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting Justices of this County to the next term of the Court, to appoint two assessors for this County: one for Northway Parish and one for Saint Luke's Parish.

Thomas J. Britton, Jonathan Dinsent, James M. Parker, & W^m. Brown are appointed Commissioners (any two of whom may act) to let out the repairing or rebuilding of the Leysen's gut bridge near Jerusalem, and they are authorized to shew the said bridge if they think properly, make report.

John Booth, R. B. Henders, Henry Leach & Edwin Harris are appointed Commissioners (any two of whom may act) to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the bridges over Tassar Creek near Boykin's Depot provided the same when completed & make report to Court.

Joshua Stym is appointed Surveyor of the road from Sharp's meeting house to Rumples' Cross roads, in the room of Edwin Jones deceased. and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

Ordered that the hands of Japhet Little be transferred from the road of which C. T. Wigham is Surveyor to that of which John James is Surveyor.

Edmund Green or Britton (free negro) on his motion he being old & infirm is exempt from all taxes & levies in future.

Ordered that the estate of Joseph M. Ferguson dec^d be committed to the hands of Samuel Halls, Sheriff of this County to be administered according to Law.

John McQuiggin is appointed Surveyor of the road from Massonburg's Mill to Cedar Swamp bridge in room of Edward S. Munfee (and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon).

E. S. Munfee is appointed Surveyor of the road from Cedar Swamp bridge to Franklin bridge in the room of John McQuiggin deceased. and it is ordered that the usual hands together with the hands belonging to the estate of the late Simon Munfee dec^d do work thereon.

The Court doth assign W^m. J. Sebrill guardian of his infant son W^m. Nicholas Sebrill. Whereupon he gave bond & security according to Law.

On the motion of W^m. B. Pope, it is ordered that James D. Bryant Administrator of Anderson Pope pay to him the sum of \$10.00. for the board of the said Anderson Pope's two children.
