Upon satisfactory evidence presented to the Court it doth certify that Mary D. Jenkins widow of William Jenkins to whom bounty land was granted under the act of Congress of March 3rd 1855, for 120 acres No. 61,750 was issued, dat'd April 11th 1856, died April 15th 1856, intestate and leaving as her only heirs at law her daughters, Martha Jenkins (and Nancy) Seabrough who has intermarried, with John Seabrough who are now living and are above the age of twenty one years.
