

Ordered that Henry S. Howard, Richard J. Dardow and James F. Gastkins be appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the Cypress gut bridge near Jerusalem, and the said Commissioners are empowered to make any alterations in the said bridge they may think proper and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

John I. Keidred who has been elected Attorney for the Commonwealth for this County for four years from the first day of July 1856, this day appeared in Court and took the several oaths prescribed by Law.

John M. Gulley, who has been elected Commissioner of the Revenue for Saint Luke's Parish in this County for the term of two years commencing the first day of January 1857, this day took the several oaths prescribed by Law, and with W^m. W. Briggs his security entered into bonds in the penalty of \$1000, conditioned as the Law directs; which bond was acknowledged by the obligors therein named and ordered to be recorded.

Samuel Kello, Sheriff of this County returned Sunday Lists of Insolvent County Debits amounting to \$307.80 which were examined by the Court and allowed.

Samuel Kello Sheriff of this County this day returned an Account with the County for the years 1854 & 1855, showing a balance due the County of \$767.76 which amount he is directed to retain in hands subject to the future orders of this Court.

Samuel Kello Sheriff of this County this day presented to the Court several lists of Taxes assessed other ^{than cannot be collected} than on real estate, to wit: one for \$16.00, another for \$24.00 and another for \$41.60 which lists having been examined by the Court and the Court being satisfied of the correctness of the same, and also satisfied that copies of said lists were posted up at the front door of the Courthouse of this County on a Court day during the next term preceding this, it is ordered that copies thereof be certified to the next Auditor.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
