

Wesley A. Pond Administrator of the estate of Francis Feltz dec'd, an account of all debts or demands against Francis Feltz dec'd or his estate, passed before him, and also an account apportioning the amount due from Wesley A. J. W. St. Drury \$23.80. Joseph C. Feltz \$3.71. G. W. Musgrave \$6.46, F. A. Bingham \$11.43, Lewis D. Feltz \$8.16 and Wm. R. Wmell, the respective amounts apportioned them in the said account with legal interest thereon from the 31st day of December 1855.
