Ordered that Abraham Dole, James Warrall and Jethro Pical bring sworn for the purpose to appraise all the goods & chattels of Jephtha Darrow dec'd that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of Meritt J. Davis & Marrison J. Davis the executors named in the last will and testament of John Davis dec'd who made oath and gave bond and security according to Law. Certificate is granted them for obtaining a probate of the will of the said John Davis dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Wm. H. Cobb, Jese B. Vick and Saml Kello bring sworn for the purpose to appraise all the goods & chattels of John Davis dec'd that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.
