 dec^d. It is ordered that the said W^m. B. Howell be summoned
 here to the next term of this Court to show cause, if any he can,
 why he should not be required to give a new bond as Adminis-
 trator of the said Archer D. G. Bond dec^d.

On the Motion of Toml. Kello. Sheriff of this County, Merit J. Davis
 is permitted to qualify as his Deputy, it being the opinion of the
 Court that he is a person of honesty, probity (and) good character,
 and therupon he took the several oaths prescribed by Law.
