English three of the subscribing witnesses thereto (and thereupon ordered to be recorded. And Thomas D. Brown the executor therein named having refused to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof, on the motion of Oliver H. Inman who made oath and together with Augustus James & Leighton W. Bailey his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to Law. Certificate is granted the said Inman for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said, Elizabeth Freeman dec^d with his will annexed in due form.
