 & William Johnson, and divers other witnesses being sworn
 and examined and the parties being fully heard by Counsel
 On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court
 that the said writing is the true last will and testament
 of the said William Denson dec'd which is thereupon
 ordered to be recorded as the true last will and testa-
 ment of the said William Denson dec'd. And on the
 motion of Arrington Gardner the executor therein named
 who made oath (and together with Levi Hunley (and
 Jefe B. Vick his securities, (who justified on oath as
 their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a
 bond in the penalty of one thousand Dollars conditioned
 according to Law, Certificate is granted him for ob-
 taining a probat of the said will in due form.

Ordered that Jefe Vick, Robert Vick, Levi Hunley,
 and James Hunley or any three of them being sworn for
 the purpose, do aspraise all the goods or chattels
 of William Denson dec'd that may be produced
 to them and make due return of the same.
