

At a Quarterly Term of the County Court of Southampton County continued
and held at the Courtroom thereof, on Tuesday the 19th day of August 1856
Present,

James E. Peters Presiding Justice, Jos. E. Bullett
and Thomas Vaughan, Justices

Ordered that the account of W^m W. Briggs Jailor of this County amounting
to \$7.50 & be certified to the auditor of public accounts for his exam-
ination and payment.

Ordered that the account of W^m W. Briggs, Jailor of this County amount-
ing to \$4.05 for committing and board of R. S. Vick a Lunatic be
certified to the Auditor of public accounts for his examination &
payment it being proved to the Court by the Jailor aforesaid that
immediately after the commitment of the said Vick application
was made to the Eastern Assembly of Virginia for admission of
the said Vick, and that before an answer was received the
said Vick was discharged by the Court as being of
sound mind

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County pay to Harrison P. Pope
\$12.00 out of any contingent moneys in his hands not otherwise
appropriated.

Upon satisfactory evidence presented to the Court it doth certify that
Martha Byrnum to whom County land warrant number 38, 541
for one hundred and twenty acres was issued under the act of
Congress of March 3^d AD 1855, which said warrant is dated
the 14th day of December in the year 1855, departed this life
on the seventeenth day of December in the year 1855, intestate (and
leaving as her only heirs at law Adolphus Byrnum, Thomas
Byrnum and Drucilla Canwell wife of John Canwell) all
of whom are now living and are above the age of twenty
one years

Ordered that Warren Edwards, Geo W. Lawrence, James Doanay
and Robert Somers be appointed commissioners to let to
the lowest bidder the repairs of the Cypress bridges
and receive the same when completed (and make report
to Court and that they be authorized to sell the old lumber of bridges.

Davis Barnett is appointed Surveyor of the road from Black
Head Signpost near his house to Amos Popes gate in
room of Philip Oland decd. and it is ordered that the
usual hands do work thereon.

Ordered that James W. Parker, Henry S. Howard, James F.
Faskins and Richard J. Darden be appointed commissioners
