

Deed of Trust dated the 1st day of September 1836, from Arthur M. Channell
to Joseph E. Gillette, conveying personal property interest to secure W^m
Thompson, Alfred Parks & John Kitchen, was admitted to record October
14th 1836

On the motion of Joseph E. Davis it is ordered that the estate of Perryⁿ Lamb
doe be committed to the hands of Saml. Kelle, Sheriff of this County to be
administered according to Law.

The Court doth certify that W^m H. Briggs Commissioner of the Prison in this
County during the year returns to the Clerk of this Court eighty four deaths
in his district and fifty one deaths, and that the said returns have been
accurately and fully made according to the Laws regulating the same,
and within the time prescribed by Law.

On the Application of Joseph H. Packham to alter the road from Northham
Cross roads to the Cross Keys road near said Packham's house. It is ordered that
W^m Ingraham, Nathaniel Simmons & Lewis Throp be appointed to view the
ground and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that will
result as well to individuals as the public if such road shall be as pro-
posed, and especially whether any yard, garden, or orchard or any part thereof
will in such case have to be taken.

Orders that the Clerk register Nancy Hall and her negro who was free
in this County as appears by the testimony of W^m E. Gay.
