

The Court doth contract with William Fowler to keep Jagers bridge free of logs & other obstructions & agree to pay him \$5.00 per year.

On the motion of James J. Darden who made oath and together with Richard J. Darden & James H. Denson, his securities, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of ten thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of Elliza Pope dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Caswell Wrennall, Jas. S. Holt, A. K. Stephenson & D. D. Strong or any three of them, being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Elliza Pope dec'd, that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of Robert S. Jones who made oath and together with Joseph W. Ireland his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one hundred & fifty dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of Rebecca Turner dec'd in due form.

Ordered that A. A. Thomas, R. W. Waller & John F. Powell being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Rebecca Turner dec'd that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of Elizabeth Porter who made oath and together with Thomas B. Wrennall, John M. Gurley, Lucy Porter & John C. Dunn her securities who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted her for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of Jacob Porter dec'd in due form.
