On the motion of James J. Dawson who made oath and together with Richard J. Dawson & James H. Faxon, his securities, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of Ten thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of Eliza Dole deceased in due form.

On the motion of Robert P. Jones who made oath and together with Joseph W. Clegg his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of one hundred & fifty dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on the estate of Rebecca Turner deceased in due form.

Ordered that A. A. Thomas, R. C. Waller & John T. Everett being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Rebecca Turner deceased that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.
