

The Court doth assign William Price guardian of James D and Andrew J. Price orphans of W^m Price dec^d. Whereupon he together with S. W. Mason & James C. Price his securities who justified on oath as to their sufficiency entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs.

The last will and testament of Japh B. Newton dec^d was proved by the oaths of W^m B. Westbrook and W^m H. Chittenden two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and thereupon and ordered to be recorded, and on the motion of Mary Ann Newton the executrix therein named who made oath and entered into a bond in the penalty of three thousand dollars conditioned according to Law (but without security the will directing that none should be required of her) Certificate is granted her for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.

Ordered that W^m B. Westbrook, W^m H. Chittenden, John H. Hitt and Samuel B. Braham or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Japh B. Newton dec^d that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of William Hedgeseth who made oath and together with Thos. J. Knicker of Erin Griffin his securities who justified on oath as to their sufficiency entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of William T. Hedgeseth dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Thos. J. Knicker, Meridian Bradshaw, John W. Hedgeseth & Willis Bradshaw, or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of W^m T. Hedgeseth dec^d that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of Abner H. Stephenson who made oath and together with Benjamin E. Pope, Davis Barnett (and Harrison P. Pope his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of sixteen thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John D. Stephenson dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Davis Barnett, Lewis W. Merrill (and Benjamin E. Pope being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of John D. Stephenson dec^d that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.
