Briden & Erin Griffin his securities who justified on oath as to their sufficiency
entered into and acknowledged abode in the penalty of one thousand Dollars
conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters
of Administration on the estate of William T. Hildgorth dec^d in due form

Ordered that Tho. J. Briden, Meridian Bradshaw, John W. Hildgorth & W^m Ellis
Bradshaw, or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise
all the goods or chattels of W^m T. Hildgorth dec^d that may be produced
to them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of John D. Stephenson who made oath and together with Benj-
amin E. Pope, Davis Barrett and Harrier D. Pope his securities (who jus-
tified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged abode
in the penalty of sixteen thousand dollars conditioned as the Law directs
Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of Administration on the
estate of John D. Stephenson dec^d in due form.

Ordered that Davis Barrett, Lewis W. Powell and Benjamin E. Pope being
sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of John
D. Stephenson dec^d that may be produced to them & make due return
of the same.
