Present, John Dutton, Justice

Calvin Lewis, a free negro, who stands charged with a felony by him committed in the County of Southampton and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this that he did, on the 9th day of December in the year 1851, in the County of Southampton, maliciously burn a certain barrel of fodder wheat, three stalks of fodder, the property of William Heming of the value of twenty dollars, that is to say, of less value than one hundred dollars, this day ^{appeared} in Court in discharge of his recognizance entered into before John D. Boykin a Justice of the peace of this County and was set to the bar in custody of the sheriff of this County and being arraigned, pleaded not guilty, and the Court having heard the evidence as of opinion that he is not guilty of the offence wherewith he stands charged, therefore it is considered by the Court that he be discharged from imprisonment and go thereof without day.
