to this time.

On the motion of Everett F. Hill who made oath and together with Bennett Bramett of
John R. Rockwell his securities (who justified out oath as to their sufficiency) entered
into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Five hundred Dollars condition
as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of adminis-
tration on the estate of Jonathan D. Buffin dec'd. in due form.

Ordered that Bennett Bramett, Benja. D. Gray of Hasket P. Cutler being
sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Jonathan
D. Buffin dec'd. that may be produced to them & make due return of the
same.
