mit a larceny was this day set to the bar in court of the Sheriff of this County
and being arraigned pleaded not guilty; and the Court having heard the
evidence and of opinion that the said Slave Isham is not guilty of the
offence with which he stands charged, It is therefore considered that he
be discharged and go thereof without day.

Ordered that the Clerk register Augustus Bailey, free negro, who was born in this
County as appears by the testimony of Wm R. Stephenson, Joshua Antin free negro
who was born in this County as appears by the testimony of Joseph Trotter, of
Sam Scott and Calbin Warren free negroes who were born free in this County as
appears by the testimony of John Trotter.

for their said contempt.
