

\$4.00 on the 25th November 1860, \$5.00 on the 25th November 1861, \$5.00 on the 25th November 1862, \$6.00 on the 25th November 1863, \$7.00 on the 25th November 1864, \$8.00 on the 25th November 1865, \$10.00 on the 25th November 1866, \$12.00 on the 25th November 1867 and \$20.00 on the 25th November 1868, and \$20.00 on the 25th November 1869. to the apprentice for the services of the apprentice.

On the application of Joseph H. Barkham to alter the road from Bethlehem Cross roads to the deep deeps road near said Barkham's house. The Commissioners appointed to view the ground proposed for said road have the said road altered as proposed by the said Barkham. This day made their report that the road had been put in good repair and received the same. It is therefore ordered that the same be established as a highway.

Ordered that the Indentures binding Nicholas Bailey a negro to Levi Hensley be transferred to Mrs. Margaret Hensley by the administrator of the said Levi Hensley dec'd.

Edwin L. Turner, who stands charged with a felony by him committed in this County and within the jurisdiction of this Court viz. that he did on the 15th of January in the year 1867 shoot at Albert B. Davis with intent to maim, disfigure, disable or kill, this day appeared in Court and on the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth and for good cause shown this examination is made continued until the next term of this Court.

Ordered that the lease register Buffin Lamb, free negro, who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Nathaniel Bishop William Bailey a negro who was born free in this County as appears by the former register, and Robert Maynor a negro who was born in this County as appears by the testimony of Joshua Britton.

The Court doth assign Pelage Carver as guardian of the infant children Sarah Ann Lamb, D. Mary A., Edith C., James M., Eugene C. & Lydia C. Carver. Whereupon he together with Wm. D. Bryant, Richard L. Bryant and John R. Rockelle his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged about the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs.

The Court doth assign Elizabeth Raiford as guardian of Everett, Martha C., Levi, Susan, John, William & Demarius Raiford orphans of William Raiford dec'd. Whereupon she together with Samuel Raiford and Robert Raiford, her securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged about the penalty of six hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs.

John Cobb, R. T. Briggs, Lang Gay and W. A. Bell are appointed Commissioners to let to the lowest bidder the rebuilding of Buffin's bridge and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

On the motion of Saml. B. Kelle who made oath and together with Saml. Kelle his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged about
