 pay to the apprentices himself the like sum of \$15.00.

 County as appears by the testimony of Benjamin F. Dick, Drutton Chappel, Matilda  
 Diggs & Luinda Diggs free negroes who were born free in this County as appears by  
 the testimony of John Crumpler, and Madison Laurent free negro who was born free in  
 this County as appears by the testimony of his former master

Wm Lambkin, Matthew Harris & Patrick Rose are appointed Commissioners to act
