William E. Rawls Adm. of Jas. R. Williams dec'd.

This day this cause came on for hearing in the Commissioner's report of Wm E. Rawls
 transactions as administrator of John R. Williams also the said Commissioner's report on
 the debts now outstanding against the said estate and to which no exceptions have
 been filed and the Court confirming the said reports and then to be recorded and the
 Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the said Wm E. Rawls after retaining in
 his hands the sum of thirty dollars to meet the costs of these accounts and
 this decree pay to the estate of James Ritchie the sum of one hundred and fifty
 one dollars and eighty three cents the balance in his hands this being the 1st
 class debts proved.

The Consent of the Court is granted Jane Hill free negro, to bind her son Robert to
 Thomas H. Vorsebant full of age. The said Thomas H. Vorsebant paying to the
 mother \$15.00 per year for the services of the apprentice after he arrives
 to the age of two years except for the last year, and for that year that he
 pay to the apprentice himself the like sum of \$15.00.

Ordered that the black register Caroline Brown free negro who was born free in this
 County as appears by the testimony of Benjamin F. Dick, Reuben Chappel, Mauda
 Diggs & Lucinda Diggs free negroes who were born free in this County as appears by
 the testimony of John Crumpler, and Madison W. Davis free negro who was born free in
 this County as appears by the testimony of his former register.

Wm Lankford, Matthew Davis & Patrick Rowe are appointed Commissioners to act
 conjointly with Commissioners to be appointed by the County Court of Isle of Wight
 County to let to the lowest bidder the repairs of Rogers bridge and receive
 the same when completed and make report to Court.

On the motion of William A. Atkinson who made oath and together with Henry M. Smith
 & Thomas J. Driscoll his securities who just paid in oath as to their sufficiency, entered into
