The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertakes the opening of said road as proposed and receive the same when completed. This day made their report which is received by the Court & it is ordered that the said road be established a public highway of this County.

On the motion of Mr. W. Briggs Sheriff of this County, Eld Davis, Jas. T. Dwyer, G. W. Lawrence, Parker D. King, Josiah Juyner (now Jas. R. Bell) are permitted to qualify as his Deputies, it being the opinion of the Court that they are men of honesty, probity and good demeanor. Whereupon they appeared and qualified by taking the several oaths prescribed by Law.

The Court doth appoint James B. Woguhart guardian of Whitwell St. Woguhart orphan of Whitwell St. Woguhart dec^d. Whereupon he together with Charles F. Woguhart), his securities, entered into an acknowledged bond in the penalty of fifty thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law (the said securities promising as to their sufficiency).

George A. Hollaman having nominated A. B. Woguhart as his guardian before a Justice of the Peace of Bedford County, Virginia, The Court doth appoint him as his guardian. Whereupon he together with Charles F. Woguhart, & James B. Woguhart, his securities (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of fifty thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law.

Marian Drake an unmarried white woman of this County having charged upon both James Nicholas of being the father of a female bastard child whereof she was delivered on the 1st of April 1857 in said County. For reasons appearing to the Court this cause is continued until the next term.
