Critchton be summoned to appear here on the first day of the next term to shew cause if any he can why an attachment should not be issued against him for his contempt.

On the motion of the attorney for the Commonwealth it is ordered that the Sheriff of the County of Brunswick be summoned to appear here on the first day of the next term to shew cause if any he can why an attachment should not be issued against him for his contempt inflicting to them according to law a certain summons which issued from the Office of this Court upon a rule made at the last term of this Court commanding him to summon James E. Critchton to appear before this Court to day to shew cause if any he can why he should not be fined for his contempt (and which summons it appears was placed by the Clerk of this Court in the post office in this place directed to the said Sheriff of Brunswick).

On the motion of Joseph S. Gladden who made oath (and together with Wm R. Stephenson his security who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into (and acknowledged above the penalty of three hundred dollars conditioned as the Law directs, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of John D. Ford deceased in due form.

Ordered that Wm R. Stephenson, Arthur A. Drury and Wm Ford being sworn for the purpose do apprise all the goods or chattels of John D. Ford deceased in due form that may be produced to them to make due return of the same.

The Board of the Overseers of the Poor of this County this day made their annual report which is ordered to be filed.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
