Magee, do hereby certify that if they and each of them, shall make their personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Court of this County on the first day of the next term to give evidence in behalf of the Commonwealth against Edson & Jones and shall not depart thence without the leave of the said Court then their recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

Mariam Drake an unmarried white woman of this County having charged upon oath James Hitchen of being the father of a female bastard child with her she was delivered with 1st of April 1857, in this said County. For reasons appearing to the Court this case is continued until the next term.

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest bidder the repair of the Bridge across Poplar Swamp below Rendall's Mill this day made their report which is ordered to be filed.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning 11 o'clock.
