

At a Quarterly Term of the County Court of Southampton County commenced and held at the Court House thereof, on Tuesday the 16th day of June 1857.
Present. James E. Patten, presiding Justice, Thomas Linn, Thomas Vaughan, W^m L. Francis, Robert M. Dole, Justices.

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of the bridge in the embankment near Jerusalem, this day made their report, which is ordered to be filed.

On the Motion of Perry Bloom. It is ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting justices of this County to the next term of this Court to take into consideration the propriety of allowing them to sell by retail and at spirit in a mixture thereof at their store in this County.

On the motion of John Dutton who made oath and together with Saml. Wells and Ro. M. Dole, his securities (who were sworn in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of \$1000. or conditions according to Law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of Wm. D. Sumner dec'd in due form.

Ordered that W. D. Moon, Jos. W. Willford, Jas. N. Jenkins of W^m W. Briggs or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Mills D. Sumner dec'd that may be produced to them of make inventory of the same.

William F. Griffin as administrator of Jeremiah Griffin dec'd. This day made choice of George W. Lawrence as his guardian. Whereupon he together with W^m W. Briggs and John J. Knicker his securities (who were sworn in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged above in the penalty of one hundred & fifty Dollars conditions as the Law directs.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting justices of this County to the next term of this Court to take into consideration the repairs or enlargement or the rebuilding of the Clerk's Office of this County, to take into consideration the propriety of allowing the Master to hold their Lodge in the Grand Jury room of the Court House.

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the repairs or rebuilding of Sumner's bridge, this day made their report which is ordered to be filed.

The Commissioners appointed to let to the lowest undertaker the rebuilding or repairs of the two bridges over Linn & Mason's Mill dam this day made their report which is ordered to be filed.
