

Deed of Trust dated 15th June 1857 from the Norfolk and Peterborough Rail Road Company to George Blount
and John M. Southgate, conveying real & personal estate, was admitted to record June 22nd 1857
Deed of Bargain & Sale dated July 1857 from James Johnson Deceased & his wife, & St. Paul's Church, of the one part
vs wife, George W. Deed & wife to Herman S. Brantley, conveying land and admitted to record June 24th 1857
as to George W. Deed.

Deed of Trust dated 27th June 1857, between W^m Whitfield wife of the first part, James Hobson of the second part, Cass
Brewer of the third part, conveying land, was admitted to record 27th June 1857.

Deed of Trust dated 25th June 1857 from W^m P. Moore to W^m C. Bay, conveying mixed estate to secure W^m
Munger was admitted to record June 29th 1857.

Deed of Trust dated 27th June 1857 from W^m P. Moore to W^m C. Bay, conveying mixed estate to secure Edwin Parker,
& James W. White, was admitted to record June 29th 1857.

Deed of Trust dated 2nd July 1857 from Robert V. Hawkins to Milton D. Butler conveying personal estate
to secure Elizabeth White, was admitted to record July 3rd 1857.

Deed of Bargain & Sale dated 11th March 1857, from Lucinda Speary to W^m Spring, conveying
Land, was admitted to record, July 11th 1857.

Ordered that Joseph W. Verghant be added to the appraisers heretofore appointed to appraise all the goods
or chattels of Whitcomb St. Verghant dec^d that may be produced to them and that any flaws of the appraisers
return the appraisement signed by them according to law.

On motion of Leonard Le Bell guardian of Frances M^y & Richard J. Vaughan he is allowed to expend
\$75⁰⁰ of each of his wards Estates for their support, education & this year

Ordered that William W. Briggs Sheriff of this County take the Estate of James Edwards dec^d into his hands
and administer the same according to law.

Ordered that A. P. Williams, Benj. Gray, Bennett P. Barrett & Joseph B. Butler or any three of them
being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of James Edwards dec^d which may be
produced or shown to them and make due return thereof signed by them.

The last Will Testament of William J. Sebrell dec^d was proved by the oaths of James A. Gillette, W^m D. West-
brook & John James the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and on the motion of James
E. Sebrell the Executor therein named who made oath and entered into & acknowledged a bond (the will
requesting him to be permitted to qualify without giving security and the Court requiring none) in the penalty
of thirty thousand ^{dollars} conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will
in due form.

Ordered that Jas. A. Gillette, John James & William D. Westbrook being first duly sworn for the purpose do
appraise all the goods or chattels of William J. Sebrell dec^d and make due return of the same signed
by them

Ely White Olney orphan of Alfred Olney, with the approbation of the Court made choice of Richard J.
Darden for her guardian who together with James J. Darden his security (who justified on oath as to their
sufficiency) entered into & acknowledged a bond in the penalty of \$100. conditioned according to law.

James D. Bryant is appointed Surveyor of the Westphalia road from the residence of Dr. P. P. Patten to the
Franklin road, and it is ordered that the hands of Tho. J. Patten, Jas. D. Bryant, Robert Murray, James W.
Patten, Joseph Jones and the tenants on the lands of Alfred Pikes do make thereon
