

Ordered that the Clerk register Anthony Read who was born free in this County as appears from the testimony of Elias Jones and Joe Brown who appear from his former register to have been born in this County.

It appears to the Court from satisfactory evidence introduced that Nancy Beale daughter of Silas Beale was born December 2<sup>d</sup> 1835, and is consequently now upwards of thirty one years of age. Which is ordered  
to be certified.

Mariam Drake an unmarried white woman of this County having charged upon said James Kitchin of being  
the father of a female bastard child whereof she was delivered on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of April 1857. The said James  
Kitchin this day appeared in Court and the said Mariam Drake & James Kitchin were personally sworn and  
examined and the parties fully heard by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court is of opinion that  
that the said James Kitchin is not the father of the said bastard child therefore it is considered that he be dis-  
charged from custody—

Persons of Thomas who has been elected Constable in District No. 1, to supply the vacancy created by the removal of Benjamin T. Applewhite late Constable in said District this day qualifies by entering into bond with security according to law and taking the oaths required by law.

Ordered that the Black Register Parker who was unanswering by the last Will & Testament of Jane Joyce  
& Faithful Servtis to her child Elizabeth who were born free in this County as appears by the evidence of Goodwin &  
Cutler

The court doth adjest John M. Burley, guardian of William Jones' option to Tidewater Island doth and  
hereupon he together with Samuel Ruth & John Moore his secretary (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency)  
entered into a written acknowledgement a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs -

doth certify that the petitioners are men of good character, and it see no objection to granting of the permission.

On the application of the Members of the Masonic Lodge No 84 of Free-masons (the Court having been summoned to consider the subject) leave is given them to hold their meetings in the grand jury room in the Courthouse of this County until the further order of the Court.

Sethon R Edwards, John J Knobell, Thomas J Proctor, James W Mifflin & Thomas Roddy are appointed commissioners to examine and report to the Court whether any & what repairs or additions are required to the Clerk's Office of this County or whether it would be preferable to build new one and the probable costs of such repairs, additions or rebuilding -

The Court taking into consideration the propriety of adopting the act entitled "An act to amend an act entitled an act to provide for the sale of unappropriated lands in the County of Sonoma and certain other Counties therein mentioned passed March 30, 1853." (the Justices having been summoned to this Court to consider the subject and a majority being present and concurring theron) doth adopt the said act. And whereupon the Court proceeding to divide the County into convenient precincts for purposes of government.
