

Absent: all the Justices except James E. Peters presiding Justice, John James Davis Norwell, Robert W. Dyer & Edwin Daugherty Justices.

Ordered that the black negroes Everett Mason & Wright Asks for negroes who were born free in this County as appears from their former registers.

James H. Judkins is appointed Surveyor of the road from Holloway Swamp bridge to the bridge at Junction in the road of Mills D. Sumner dec. and ordered that the usual bonds be made thereon.

On motion of Nancy Sumner: Ordered that Joseph E. Gillette, Roy Dwyer, Jeremiah Willford & H. D. Moore or a majority of them do sell and assign to Nancy Sumner - one third in value of the real estate of which her husband Mills D. Sumner dec. bequeathed to be held by her after life as and for her dower therein and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that C. B. Magid, John H. Smith, Jesse Little & Elijah Adams or a majority of them do advertise of money sealed proposals for the repairs or rebuilding, as they may deem best, of Carys bridge, that they determine which of the proposals shall be accepted and to reduce to writing a contract between themselves and the person whose proposal they shall accept and to take bond & security from the contractor according to law and report their proceedings to Court.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County out of any contingent money in his hands not otherwise appropriated pay to Wm. Murfee Com. \$22.14 of amount of his account.

Ordered that the account of James A. Gillette amounting to \$5.34 be certified to the Auditor of Public accounts for his examination and payment.

The Court doth assign Harrison B. Pope guardian to his infant children Russell Robinson Pope & Joseph Benjamin Pope and therefore he together with Geo. B. Pope, Wm. C. Pope his Son-in-law (who justified in oaths as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twelve thousand dollars, conditioned as the law directs.
