Edmund Underwood who stands charged with a felony by him committed in the County of Southampton and within the jurisdiction of this Court in this County, that the said Edmund Underwood did, in the County of Southampton on the 30th day of May A.D. 1857, maliciously and unlawfully shoot Jasper Beale, with intent to maim, disfigure, disable and kill the said Beale was set to the bar in custody of the factor of this County and the Court having heard the evidence is of opinion that a felony has been committed and that there is probable cause to charge the said Edmund Underwood therewith, wherefore nowm^t bound for trial stand before the Circuit Court of this County and on the motion of the said Edmund Underwood he is allowed to give bail for his personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Court of Southampton County on the first day of the next Term thereof to stand his trial for the felony aforesaid with he stands charged by entering into a recognizance himself in the sum of five hundred dollars with good security on the like sum of five hundred dollars. Whereupon the said Edmund Underwood with Mills Brett Parker Revill, Thomas Everett & Peleg Barlow^{his guardian} here in Court severally acknowledge themselves indebted to the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say the said Edmund Underwood in the sum of five hundred dollars and the said Mills A Brett Parker Revill Thomas Everett & Peleg Barlow on the like sum of five hundred Dollars, of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to be sold for the use of the Commonwealth to be rendered.

But upon this condition that of the said Edmund Underwood shall make his personal appearance before the Judge of the Circuit Court of Southampton County on the first day of the next Term thereof by 12 O'clock M. to stand his trial for the felony of which he is accused in this that he did in the County of Southampton on the 30th day of May 1857 maliciously and unlawfully shoot Jasper Beale with intent to maim, disfigure, disable and kill the said Beale and shall not depart without the leave of the said Court than this recognizance to be void.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
