Pittow, who made oath and together with Joshua Pittow and Samuel Pittow, his securities, (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Amr Pittow deceased in due form.

A Willing bearing date the 14th day of May 1834, was this day produced to the Court as the last will and testament of Benjamin Crumppler deceased. On consideration of the same, the Court is of opinion that the same is not valid and refuse to administer probate.

Ordered that Jas. G. Jones, Geo. W. Spyry, Alfred T. Chapman, & M. McCayton or any three of them being soon for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Benjamin Crumppler deceased that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

Ordered that John Pittow be appointed receiver in pursuant to 27 in the County in the sum of £1000.00.

Ordered that the Sheriff of the County enter of the contingent money in his hands by to Thomas Rogers £7.00, to Wm. Rogers £5.35, Jon Readshaw £5.25, Solomon Johnson £5.25 and to Army Head £4.50 for publishing.
