

Deed of Bargain and sale, dated Dec^r 16th 1857 from James Barnes and wife to Henry M. Baker, Lemington Lane, was admitted to record, January 12th 1858.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County pay to William H. Stappell the sum of \$2.00 the amount of a County Levy erroneously charged to him out of any contingent moneys in the hands of the said Sheriff not otherwise disposed of.

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County pay to Dalton W. Scott \$2.00 the amt of a County Levy erroneously charged to him & paid by him out of any contingent moneys in the hands of the said Sheriff not otherwise disposed of.

On the motion of David Danell he is exempted in future from the payment of all taxes and fees in his negro Jack he being ~~an~~ blind.

The last will and testament of Henry Council dec^d was this day proved by the oaths of Joseph H. Council and John A. Council, two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and sworn to be record. &c. And on the motion of James Reister the executor therein named who made oath ~~and~~ together with John Edwards and Alfred T. Stephens his securities (who qualified in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged and in the penalty of two hundred Dollars conditioned as the Law directs. Certificate is granted the said James Reister for obtaining a probat of the said Will of the said Henry Council dec^d in due form.
