Soff by his attorney and the Sheriff having made return that he had executed the said attachment on Lucinda Francis who is indebted to the defendant George R. Sumner and summoned her as a garnishee and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the garnishee is indebted to the said defendant in the sum of \$80.00 and the said defendant not appearing, though solemnly called, and it appearing by the testimony of a witness that the defendant is indebted to the plaintiff in the sum of \$119.53, with interest thereon from the 30th July 1857 till paid, it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the said defendant the said \$119.53 with interest thereon from the 30th July 1857 till paid and his costs by him in this behalf expended, And it is ordered that the said Lucinda Francis pay to the plaintiff the aforesaid sum of \$80.00 towards satisfying this judgment.
