

The Account of Allen Edwards administration in the estate of Robert G Edwards
 dec^d and James G. Jones administration in the estate of John L. Hunt dec^d having previously
 been examined and approved in the Clerk's office and there being no exceptions thereto
 ✓ were severally examined, confirmed and ordered to be recorded

Ordered that the Sheriff of this County summon all the acting Justices of this
 County to the next term of this Court to take into consideration the propriety
 of allowing the Merchants of this County to sell by retail at their respective stores
 Admit Spirits as a mixture thereof

The Impression taken at the House of W^m R. Parker in this County on the 31st
 day of February 1838, before Elliott L. May, a Justice of the peace of said County
 upon the view of the body of James Love a free boy of colour there
 lying dead, was this day returned and ordered to be filed

On the motion of Richard L. Bryant who made oath and together with
 W^m D. Bryant, Benjamin J. Bryant, & W^m J. Mallett (his securities who just-
 ficed an oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond
 in the penalty of Three thousand Dollars and upwards according to Law, but fi-
 ✓ cing is granted him for obtaining letters of administration in the estate of
 Lewis Shorpe dec^d in due form

Ordered that W^m D. Bryant, Ben J. Bryant, Peleg Carver and Thomas
 Everett or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise
 all the goods & chattels of Lewis Shorpe dec^d that may be produced
 to them and make due return of the same

For reasons appearing to the Court, It is ordered that an overseer of the poor
 of this County do bind Dempsey Holland to Allen H. Cotton. And
 is ordered by the Court that Allen H. Cotton pay to the ap-
 prentice when he shall arrive to the age of twenty one years the
 sum of \$150. for the services of the apprentice for the
 payment of which sum the overseer according to this order shall take
 bond of the master

On the application of W^m Jenkins to alter the road near his house
 leading from Rock of road near his house to Swampy Swamp. It is
 ordered that Alfred Stephenson, W^m G. Stephenson and Mr. M. Clayton
 be appointed Commissioners to view the ground proposed for opening said
 road and report to the Court the conveniences and inconveniences that
 will result as well to individuals as the public and especially
 ✓ whether any yard, garden or orchard or any part thereof will in such
 case have to be taken

On the motion of Mills C. Marshall against Patrick Dolan and Robert
 1541 Nichols, survivors of the late John L. Whiting, late Constable in the
 County of Southampton. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and
