Having severally lain one month upon the Clerk's office and there being no exception thereto were severally examined & confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

Gillette his security (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency)) entered into and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of Six hundred dollars conditioned according to Law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Matthew Moore dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Jos. E. Gillette, J. D. Waplesburg and Mc<sup>int</sup> A. Waplesburg being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Matthew Moore dec'd that may be produced to them & make due return of the same.

The Last Will and Testament of Jesse Branch dec'd. was this day solemnly proved by the oath of Richard H. Vick another subscribing witness thereto and the same having been proved by the oath of William L. Loomis a subscribing witness thereto at the last term of this Court, was thereupon ordered to be recorded. And on the motion of Julius J. Branch the executor thereof named who made oath and together with John J. Holmes, his security, (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of Three hundred dollars conditioned according to Law. Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that Wm. H. Summrell, Geo. P. Beighin, and Henry D. Drury being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels of Jesse Branch dec'd that
