

Ordered that Jos. E. Gellotte, John Moon, Jos. J. Dabon and William Edwards or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods or chattels of Martha Vaughan dec'd that may be produced to them and make one return of the same.

W^m E. Gay & William Edwards two of the Justices of the Peace of this County are appointed to act conjointly with the Justices of Mansfield County Court to let to the lowest bidder the keeping of a ferry at South Ferry across Blue Water river, & make report to Court.

Saml. Drury & Thomas Newsum two of the Justices of the Peace of this County are appointed to let to the lowest bidder the repairs or rebuilding of the three cracks bridges & receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Dimasius L. Dolos one of the Justices of the Peace of this County is appointed to let to the lowest bidder the building of a bridge across the road near Iron Cuff's and receive the same when completed & make report to Court.

Ordered that W^m W. Briggs, the Sheriff of this County, take into his hands the estate of Nicholas Baymont dec'd. and administer the same according to Law.

Godwin Parker who has been elected Constable in District No. 4. in this County for the term of two years commencing on the first day of July, 1858, together with W^m E. Gay and Joseph E. Gellotte his securities, entered into and acknowledged bonds in the penalty of five thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, whereupon he took the several oaths prescribed by Law, which bond is now to be recorded.

W^m E. Gay who has been elected Commissioner of the Poorhouse for Nottingham Parish in this County for two years commencing first day of January 1859, together with Jos. Dabon and Godwin Parker, his securities, entered into and acknowledged bonds in the penalty of one thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law whereupon he took the several oaths prescribed by Law, which bond is now to be recorded.

The Court taking into consideration the proposals for letting to the lowest bidder the repairs of Swamp bridge across the said Swamp by the Commissioners at the last term of this Court, doth accept the proposal of Shugars Land at \$1660.00 and appoint W^m W. Branch, Alexander Thompson, Patrick Dolos and John B. Bayham Commissioners to reduce to writing a contract between this County and the said Shugars Land and to take bond from him with a sufficient security or securities in a penalty at double the amount he is to receive under the contract, payable to this County with condition for the faithful performance of the contract and return the same to Court.
