

John S. Shivers of Henry S. Howard, his securities (who justifies in oath as to this sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged bond in the penalty of five hundred Dollars conditioned according to law, whereupon is granted him full attorney letters of administration on the estate of Wells W. Kitchen dec'd in due form.

Monroe Gray, Jonathan Darden and W^m Whitehead are appointed appraisers, after being sworn for the purpose, to appraise all the goods or chattels of Wells W. Kitchen dec'd that may be produced to them and make due return of the same.

Ordered that the Clerk register Phidias W. Whitney free negro who was born free in this County as appears by the testimony of Elijah J. Williams.

Edwin R. Story, who has been elected Constable in District No 3 in this County for the term of two years commencing on the first day of July 1858, together with H. P. Pope, Geo. C. Pope, J. D. Story, & W. C. Myrick, his securities, entered into and acknowledged bond in the penalty of Five thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, whereupon he took the several oaths prescribed by Law, which bond is ordered to be recorded.

W^m W. Briggs, who was on the 27th day of May in the year 1858, duly elected Sheriff of the County of Southampton to serve as such for the term of two years commencing on the 1st day of January 1859, and afterwards until his successor is qualified to enter upon the discharge of the duties thereof, this day appeared with and was together with James D. Bryant, Bay. B. Knives, Geo. J. Knives and Geo. C. Briggs decs. W. Lawrence, L. R. Edwards, Geo. H. Thib. W^m B. Shaws, Thos. R. Briggs & Geo. W. Vick his securities, entered into and acknowledged bond in the penalty of twenty thousand Dollars conditioned for the faithful execution of the duties of his office - which bond is ordered to be recorded by the Clerk of this Court, who is also directed to transmit a copy of said Bond and a copy of this Order to the Auditor of Public Accounts. And thereupon the said W^m W. Briggs took the several oaths required by Law.

Henry Bailey is appointed Overseer of road from Campbells Sea Beach Swamp land to Shade Baykins old place in place of Drury Bond dec'd and it is ordered that the usual hands do work thereon.

The report of the Court is granted to Mrs. Mary Bennett to bind her minor children Henry Bennett, aged about 15 years, Benjamin Bennett aged about 10 years, Bryant Bennett aged about 12 years, and Robert Bennett aged about 10 years to Henry Samuels.
