It appearing upon satisfactory evidence that Nathaniel Chambliss to whom a homestead warrant for 120 acres was issued under an act of Congress of March 3^d 1855 the number of which said warrant is number 59,255 and is dated December 20th 1855 departed this life on the 19th day of January 1856 intestate and leaving as his only heirs at law his children Henry Chambliss Rebecca Chambliss & Evaline Chambliss the two last of whom are minors and the said Henry has been appointed their guardian by the Court. It is therefore ordered that the said Henry Chambliss make sale of the said land warrant and of the net proceeds retain one third to his own benefit and the other two thirds equally for the said Rebecca & Evaline and the said Henry Chambliss is ordered to report to the Court.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
