Bykin processors in precinct No 37 to appear here at the next term of this Court to show cause, if any they can, why they have not made their reports & that they make their reports to the next Court.

The last Will and Testament of David Harris dec^d. was proved by the Oaths of J. D. Drury & J. B. Briggs the subscribing witnesses thereto and was thereupon ordered to be recorded and on the motion of S. H. Mesgrove the executor therein named who made oath to the truth and Edw. Harris & James J. Darden his securities (who testified as to their sufficiency) ventured oath and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of fifty thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probat of the said will in due form.

Ordered that Edwin Harris, Nathan D. Thomas, James H. Person & S. B. Briggs or any three of them being sworn for the purpose do appraise all the goods & chattels ^{and real estate} of David Harris dec^d that may be perceived taken & make due return of the same.

On the motion of Richard Barnett guardian of Orasmus B. Barnett he is allowed to expend the sum of \$350.00 of his ward's income per annum for the years 1857 & 58 for his support, education &c.
