

Deed of trust dated 8<sup>th</sup> day of November 1858, between John Reidt, of the first part & Co's W. Dick of the second part, and Geo. W. Sperry of the third part conveying mixed estate, was admitted to record November 11<sup>th</sup> 1858.

Deed of trust dated 19<sup>th</sup> October 1858, from CO'S St. Bishop to R. J. Fitch, conveying personal estate to secure John H. Stith Jr., was admitted to record November 13<sup>th</sup> 1858.

Ordered that the amount of Littler R. Edwards, Clerk of this Court amounting to £10.50 be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination & payment.

The Court doth allow L. R. Edwards, Clerk of this Court twenty five dollars for his services in examining & certifying the books of the Commissioners of the Revenue of this County to the Auditor, which his orders to be certified to the Auditor of public accounts for his examination & payment.

Howell Procurators in precinct No 35 of this County & John S. Bigelow Procurator in precinct No 37 to appear here at the next term of this Court to show cause, if any they can, why they have not made their reports & that they make their reports to the next Court.

The last Will and Testament of Revil Harris dec'd. was proved by the Oaths of J. D. Alday & J. E. Briggs the subscribers witnesses thereto and was then pronounced to be recorded and on the motion of C. M. Blagrove the executor therein named who made oath together with Edmon Harris & James J. David his son witness (who justified as such as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged above in the presence of fifty thousand Dollars conditions according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that Edmon Harris, Ruthin B. Thomas, James A. Conroy Esq. & Briggs or any three of them ~~are~~ <sup>are</sup> sworn for the purpose to appraise all the goods & chattels of Revil Harris dec'd. that may be produced before them & make due return of the same.

On the motion of Richard Banet guardian of Ernest R. Banet he is allowed to spend the sum of £50.00 of his wife's income per annum for the years 1857 & 58 for his support, whereupon
