Thomas as her guardian as appears by her certificate acknowledged before a justice of the peace of this County, he is permitted to qualify. Whereupon he together with Benjamin B. Knired & Jos^{ph} B. Briggs his securities (who justified in oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged abroad in the penalty of two hundred Dollars conditioned according to Law.
