Whereupon he together with Warren Edwards & Esther Gold his co-guardians (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency), entered into an acknowledgment abroad in the penalty of five thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law.

Ordered that Henry M. Rattle one of the Commissioners of roads of this County have the embarkment at the aforementioned bridge ^{and also the bridge} put in good repairs & make report to Court.

Ordered that the accounts of Nathl R. Blaw jailer of this County, the one amounting to \$5.25 & the other \$51.00 be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination & payment.
