A Certificate of the estate of John Newton, a Lunatic, was this day returned to the Court by the Justices who ordered him to be confined in an asylum, which is ordered to be filed.

On the motion of Robert H. Proctor who made oath and together with Thomas J. Proctor, his son-in-law, (who justified on oath as to his sufficiency) entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand Dollars conditioned according to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Thomas R. Proctor dec'd in due form.

The last Will and testament of Joel Nick dec'd was this day proved by the oaths of John L. Brown & Thomas B. Howell the subscribing witnesses thereto and thereupon ordered to be recorded.

John C. Briggs, Wm M. Parker, L. H. Bishop, Elijah Sawyer, Wm W. Briggs, Joseph D. Gillette, Wm Atkinson, E. C. Maget, Ephraim Dim, Alfred S. Stephenson, Joseph W. Colcord, & William J. Branch are appointed School Commissioners in this County for the next year ensuing and the Sheriff is ordered to notify them of their appointment.

Ordered that the accounts of Geo. A. Powell, Constable the one amounting to \$20.20 & the other to \$17.10 be certified to the Auditor of Public Accounts for his examination & payment.

All matters of course pending in this Court & not otherwise disposed of are severally continued.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next term.
