 will probably keep a house orderly, useful and such as the law requires -
 Whereupon he in open Court entered into bond in the penalty of two hundred
 dollars, with sufficient security, conditioned according to Law, and took the
 oath prescribed by Law.

On the motion of Charles F. Wyckham, guardian of F. N. & M. N.
 Wyckham explains of James B. Wyckham dec'd. he is authorized to
 sell London a slave, the property of his wards and he is required to
 make report of his proceedings under this order to the Court.

Geo. W. Sumner, the executor named in the last will and Testament of
 Joseph D. W. Sumner dec'd. this day refused to take upon himself the
 burden of the execution thereof. On the motion of W. H. Sumner
 who made oath and together with Samuel B. Kello and Joshua Drutten, his
 brethren (who justified on oath as to their sufficiency) entered into and
 acknowledged bond in the penalty of ten thousand dollars conditioned ac-
 cording to Law, Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of
 administration on the estate of Joseph D. W. Sumner dec'd in due form.

 or any three of them being sworn for the purpose, do appraise all the
 goods or chattels of Joseph D. W. Sumner dec'd. that may be pro-
